

Emma Trounson - Musical Director

Emma is a professional Choral Conductor, Soprano, Viola player and singing/instrumental teacher who became Musical Director of the Semper Singers in September 2013. She is also the Musical Director of Fosse Singers (Leicester). Emma

works as a Choral Director for Leicester Cathedral, where she assists with the training of the choristers, teaches singing to classes of primary school children and directs the Loughborough Children's Choir. She previously conducted Cheddar Male Choir, (Somerset); Redland Green Community Chorus, (Bristol); and St Cecilia Singers (Northamptonshire). Emma graduated from Bristol University with a BA(hons) in Music and French in 2010, and from the Royal Welsh College of Music and Drama with an MA in Choral Conducting in 2012.
